To facilitate oversight of the ASAM Patient Placement Criteria (ASAM PPC), ASAM's Board of Directors has authorized a review process, executed by the Steering Committee of the Coalition for National Clinical Criteria, which has been in existence since the publication of the first edition of the ASAM PPC in 1991.

The ASAM Criteria are not intended to be a reimbursement guideline, but rather to provide clinical guidance as to the most appropriate placement for an individual patient who demonstrates a specific set of symptoms and behaviors. If the criteria only covered the levels of care commonly reimbursable by private insurance carriers, they would not address many of the resources of the public sector and thus would tacitly endorse limitations on a complete continuum of care.

Admission Criteria By ASAM Level

The ASAM Criteria text describes treatment as a continuum marked by four broad levels of service and an early intervention level.Within the five broad levels of care, decimal numbers are used to further express gradations of intensity of services.These levels of care provide a standard nomenclature for describing the continuum of recovery-oriented addiction services.
